DTG Printer Operation & Maintenance Checklist

Daily Tasks

- Clean print heads and wipers.
- Run a nozzle check before printing.
- Shake white ink cartridges to prevent settling.
- Wipe down platen and keep work area dust-free.

Weekly Tasks

- Agitate all ink cartridges and lines.
- Check and clean capping station.
- Inspect for dried ink or clogs.
- Flush waste ink tank if near full.

Monthly Tasks
